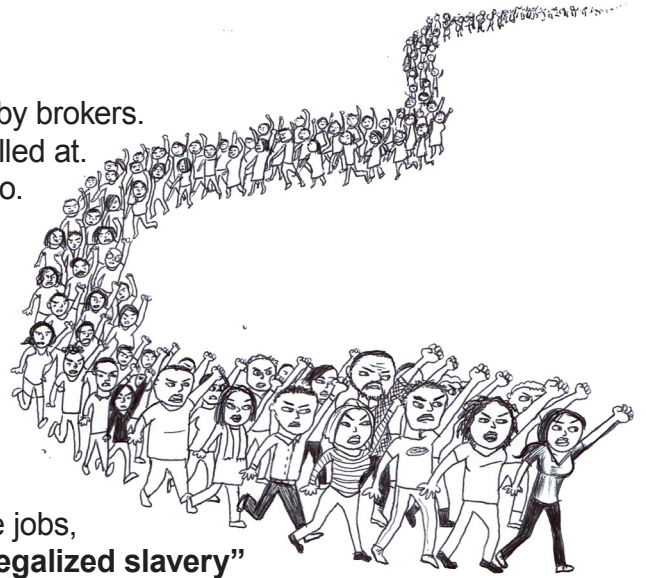


# Overworked? Underpaid? Let's meet and talk.

During the past months, we've talked with many working people in South Florida. We learned that most of us face similar problems:

- \* **Call center** employees denied vacation time.
- \* **Truck drivers** misclassified as contractors and squeezed by brokers.
- \* **Warehouse** workers denied overtime pay and routinely yelled at.
- \* **Day laborers** not paid for the type of work they're told to do.
- \* **Public sector** employees with union bureaucrats often more sympathetic to management.
- \* People with **disabilities** paid much lower than minimum wage to package products for big corporations.
- \* **Construction** workers whose safety is compromised.
- \* **Farm** workers poisoned by toxic chemicals.
- \* **Office, retail and hospitality** employees facing sexual harassment, racism, and general disrespect.
- \* Many working people unjustly fired, having to work multiple jobs, unable to make ends meet, feeling trapped in underpaid **"legalized slavery"**



As individuals, we often feel we have little choice but to suck it up and suffer. But if we unite, and back each other up, we could fight back, and even win.

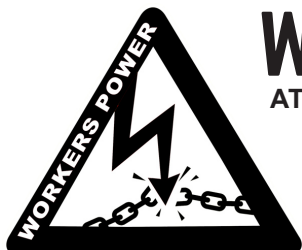
**Let's get together for a brief presentation and open discussion about how we can begin to organize a workers movement against exploitation and abuse. Bring your stories, opinions, and ideas!**
